**\*GUMSHOE offers financial support toward out of state participants' travel expenses**

Participants in each 6 month program will...

- Attend an in-person, intensive grantwriting workshop
- Work twice a month for 30 minutes with an assigned coach to prepare a grant application
- Work with an assigned NIH Grant Program Officer to review the grant applications in both early and late stages
- Submit the grant application for review by an experienced NIH funded investigator
- Finalize and submit the application with support from NRMN faculty
