Eligibility Criteria:

- Participate in the AAMC Mid-C Career Conference in September 2024
- Hold an associate professor level faculty appointment for 2 years or more
- Individuals from historically or currently underrepresented groups in science and medicine as defined by the NIH are encouraged to apply
- Be committed to pursuing an academic research career
- Aspire to promotion to the rank of full-professor and/or advancement towards a professional leadership position

Program Elements:

- Small group executive coaching
- Mentoring and peer-peer mentoring
- Longitudinal, culturally responsive leadership skills training
- Individualized research mentoring
- A partnered leadership project that addresses an institutional problem or opportunity
