The Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning Consortium to Advance Health Equity and Researcher Diversity (AIM-AHEAD) program is funded by The National Institutes of Health (NIH) and is committed to building partnerships and relationships that enhance the participation and representation of underrepresented groups in the development AI/ML models. AIM-AHEAD participants seek to improve the capabilities of emerging technology to address health disparities and inequities. AIM-AHEAD's mission is to serve those impacted by health disparities and improve health care by leveraging AI/ML potential to accelerate biomedical innovation.

AIM-AHEAD will be launching multiple research, capacity-building and training programs in early 2025. Application will be solicited for these programs beginning in March 2025. AIM-AHEAD programs seek to address healthcare disparities in underrepresented communities by promoting AI/ML researcher diversity. Applications are open to stakeholder groups including academic institutions, community organizations, healthcare organizations, small businesses, public health organizations and faith-based organizations. Training programs are designed for graduate students, post doctorates, early-career faculty, and professionals in advanced data analysis.
